

COMMUNITY CERTIFICATIONS RESIDENTS PREFERENCE PROGRAM (RPP)

The City of Milwaukee Department of Public Works helps individuals from the community gain access to employment opportunities on various construction projects in the city. Contractors bidding on certain public and private projects within the City of Milwaukee and Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD) financed with public tax dollars must hire a percentage of City of Milwaukee residents to work on these projects.

QUALIFICATIONS

- ✓ Be a City of Milwaukee resident
- ✓ Meet one of the following:
 - Laid off for the last 15 consecutive days
 - Worked less than 1,200 hours in the last 12 months
 - Meet certain federal poverty guidelines

TO GET RPP CERTIFIED, YOU MUST BRING:

1. Valid Wisconsin driver's license, WI state ID, or a picture identification card with a current City of Milwaukee address.

2. If your ID matches your current City of Milwaukee address, you must bring 1 piece of mail that was dated in the last 90 days, such as a current utility bill, cellphone bill, insurance bill, unemployment statement, bank statement, or a child support statement (non-junk mail) that matches your ID.

OR

If your ID does not have your current City of Milwaukee address, you must bring **2 pieces** of mail dated in the last 90 days from **2 different** senders addressed to the City of Milwaukee address you are residing at, such as a current utility bill, cellphone bill, insurance bill, unemployment statement, bank statement, or child support statement (non-junk mail).
